## The Family Action Children and Loss Project aims:

Children and young people may be deeply affected by the death of someone significant in their lives.

Grief is not an illness but a natural process and most young people will learn to live with their losses.

Some young people, however, may need help to cope with their loss experiences.

The Family Action Children and Loss Project aims to support children in the Bradford area who have experienced the death of a significant person in their lives

## The Family Action Children and Loss Project offers:

- **Individual therapeutic work with children and young people aged 5-18 years.** Play, creativity and space to talk can help the child share thoughts and feelings as they make sense of their new situation.
- **Information and advice to families** to help them support their children and to signpost onto other services if appropriate.
- **Therapeutic group work for children and young people** to give them a chance to meet with others in similar situations to share their experiences in a safe and supportive environment.
- **Multi-agency bereavement awareness training for professionals** to develop their understanding of issues affecting bereaved children and their families and to feel more confident in identifying ways of supporting them in their grief.
