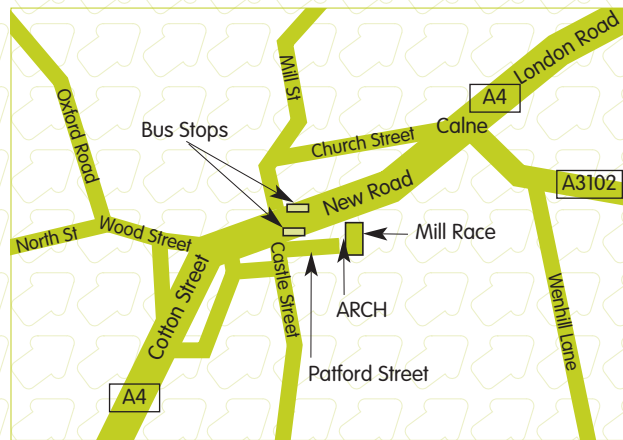

## Where Are We?

The Mill Race is close to the centre of Calne and is a wheelchair accessible single storey extension attached to the Marden House Centre. Marden House is a Grade II listed building providing a venue for community events and has become a popular community resource.

The building has a beautiful garden to the rear which is accessible to anyone using the centre. Local shops and bus routes are only a short walk away.

## What Do We Provide?
