We will treat you with respect and consult with you on all issues during our period of working with you.

We will keep everything you tell us confidential; no information will be passed on without your permission. The only exception is where you, a child or another adult is considered to be at risk, but even then we will always inform you of the steps that we take.

We will let you see anything we write down about you.

We will ask your opinion on the project and involve you in decisions we make about the project.

We will be sensitive towards your cultural and religious beliefs.

We will provide a range of services.

We will let you know how to complain if you are not happy with the project.
