SUPA Kids Project

SUPA Kids Project works with young people aged 5 - 18 years. The main aim of the service is to help young people living with current or past parental substance misuse, to keep safe, both physically and emotionally.

What we offer:

SUPA Kids offer a range of services including:

- Individual counselling
- Group work
- Recreational activities
- Help accessing other resources
- Parenting advice, support, and group work programmes

SUPA Kids will, where possible, work in partnership with other agencies and service providers.

What has worked so far

SUPA Kids has been working with young people since 2003.

Over the years, many children and young people have been supported through individual and group sessions.

Individual sessions may cover:

- Artwork
- Craft

- Identity
- Relationship Issues/Concerns
- Family
- Keeping Safe
- Health
- Home Life
- Feelings
- Behaviour

Group work may cover:

- Martial Arts
- Outings
- Bowling
- Anger
- Self-esteem
- Dance
- Acting
