Children who care is a service provided by Family Action within the Royal Borough of Greenwich which provides help and support to children and young people who care for an adult or another child.

As part of the service we provide:

- Support for the child or young person who cares and their family to get more of the help and support they need so that the caring role is reduced.
- Someone to be there to listen to the child or young person if they need to talk
- The opportunity to have fun through activities and days out with other children and young people who care
- Groups to learn new things and meet new people
- Links to other useful services and universal services

We are looking for volunteers to help support activities or provide mentoring for children and young people who care in Greenwich. In return we can offer support and training to increase your skills and experience. You should be able to commit to a minimum of 1 day per fortnight, although this can be flexible.

The children and young people we support are highly diverse and we welcome applications from all sections of the community.
