In-house Training for Your Organisation

Mental Health First Aid (Youth)

Our two-day MHFA-accredited workshop looks at how to identify, understand and help a young person who may be developing a mental health issue.

Domestic Violence

This workshop will help delegates understand what domestic abuse is, recognise signs of abuse, and be aware of support available to victims.

Death, Grief and Bereavement

This workshop will help early years staff better understand the initial reactions of children experiencing bereavement, and explore practical ways of supporting them.

Female Genital Mutilation (FGM)

Delegates will examine the cultural context of FGM, potential risk indicators, recent case law and legislation, and how to approach girls who may be affected.
