The free event on the 26th April, which has been organised by Family Action's Peterborough's SENDIAS Support service together with volunteers and other local services, is an opportunity for families, from across Peterborough, with children who are pre/post diagnosis of ASD/ADHD to listen to guest speakers and meet other parents and carers facing similar challenges and issues. This event is also aimed at professionals as well as families. Georgia McCormick, who has two children with additional needs, will share her journey that continues to date, and welcomes the opportunity to speak with other parents in a similar situation.

"I am delighted to be invited to speak at the ASD/ADHD Information Sharing Day. As a mum of two children with additional needs I know how important it is to meet other families in a similar situation to share and learn from each others' experiences and also to find out what support there is available"

Other speakers include parent, Caroline Brookes, Think Autism's Elisa Ferriggi, Julie Allen from ADHD Solutions and Lorraine Cuff from CPFT NHS. Think Autism and ADHD Solutions together with Sleep Solutions and Contact a Family will also be delivering workshops. There will also be information stands from organisations offering practical advice.

"Families affected by ASD/ADHD can feel isolated and may not know which way to turn for support. This event will allow people to make contact with other families where they can share their experiences and hopefully feel they are not so alone.
