

## Wandsworth Family Action Young Carers Service

### Sessional Young Carers Project Workers

**Salary £12 per hour**

**Hours: As required to meet service gaps during peak times ie holiday periods.**

*'A young carer is a child or young person, under the age of 18, whose life is restricted because of the need to care for someone who is frail or ill, has a disability or mental health condition or is affected by substance misuse.'*

The Wandsworth Young Carers Service provides support for young carers and their families and ensures there is an opportunity to engage in positive activities and meet other young people in the same circumstances. In addition we offer targeted 1:1 work, awareness raising, service promotion and multiagency training

The Wandsworth Young Carers Service needs support from sessional project workers to maintain a consistent service at peak times. You may be asked to work at short notice, depending on your availability. This role can involve working 'out of hours' and weekends.

The responsibilities include:

- Helping at the Thursday evening club
- Support with activities 'out of hours' and at weekends
- Assessment of Young Carer needs
- 1:1 support for Young Carers
- Home visits
- Administrative tasks

The role will involve working with families in the home and community in close liaison with the Young Carers Team and partner agencies. There will be a focus on achieving positive outcomes and improving the wellbeing and life opportunities for young carers.

**You must have experience of direct work (paid or voluntary) with children, families or vulnerable adults, ideally including some experience with people from minority ethnic communities and a working and theoretical knowledge of all aspects relating to the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults.**
