A sound knowledge of child development and the assessment process is essential as is sharing our commitment to co-production. You will have experience of and the ability to act in the Lead Professional role and evidence of the ability to collate and analyse information.

The post will involve working with families across the locality of Stockton-On-Tees. You must have access to a vehicle for business purposes and be able to travel frequently, with the expectation you will work collaboratively with Family Action & key delivery partners across the North Region of the country.
