Naturally, we are keen to expand on this success to allow other people to benefit. Funded by Wandsworth Clinical Commissioning Group we are currently running a service from six GP surgeries in the London Borough of Wandsworth, which cover Battersea, Tooting, Balham, Streatham, Putney and Roehampton

The service has developed and we are now keen to appoint a senior practitioner who will be responsible for supporting the WellFamily team and developing a team of students/volunteers to further enhance the service. We are looking for someone with management experience of staff and student placements with a background in counselling, social work, therapy or advice work. You will be required to work collaboratively with the manager to develop and refine the service. You will also hold your own cases and be required to develop local knowledge to help the team work in a solution-focused way, assess clients, and signpost to other relevant services. Our sessions take place mostly during the day but we are looking to expand these to some evenings and a Saturday morning.
