The Isle of Man Family Support Service is a voluntary service commissioned by the Department of Health and Social Care that offers a holistic, whole family approach. We are a professional, home-based service designed to meet the needs of the children and families with multiple, complex needs.

We work alongside families dealing with mental health problems, difficulties with parenting or with their own relationship, domestic abuse, and children with behavioral difficulties, problems engaging in education and emotional or physical welfare issues. We practice within a multi-agency context, meaning that we work cooperatively alongside other local services so that families' needs are met as best as possible.

You will provide early support to children and the families of children with additional needs (CwAN) and improve their overall well being and quality of life. You will assess the needs of children, young people, and their parents, and review those assessments at regular intervals in order to make sure that they remain accurate and up to date.

An NVQ level 3 or equivalent in Health, Childcare, Social care, Counselling or other relevant professional or academic qualification is essential.

You will be able to demonstrate experience of working with and supporting children and families, including experience of working within the family home and community settings
