You will facilitate contact arrangements for families, often where contact has been court ordered and complete reports relating to these sessions. All sessions provide both children and parents with practical and emotional support to ensure the contact session is as far as is possible a positive experience for all parties. You will ensure children are safe and their wellbeing is safeguarded during contact sessions.

The successful candidate will have experience of working with children and families in this type of setting and hold a relevant qualification or have experience of working with families. They will be child focused and have a good understanding of the importance of safeguarding and an awareness of some of the issues that can lead to conflict in families. They will have excellent communication and organizational skills, and good timekeeping skills. They will be able to show initiative and work well as part of a team, be flexible in their approach and committed to improving outcomes for children and families.
