The post holder will hold a minimum NVQ Level 4 qualification or equivalent in the relevant discipline such as health, social care, early years, education, or youth work. They will bring an extensive experience of managing a broad range of interventions and service models for children and families, evidence-based practice and promoting resilience. The post holder should be committed to continued professional development and have an excellent knowledge of underpinning theories of practice models and interventions and their application.

This role will be home based with the expectation to travel within the region as required to effectively oversee and support the wide portfolio of services within its remit.
