What do we do?

Families Together Leeds works with families to offer trauma-informed parenting support on routines, boundaries, behaviour management and emotional regulation, using parenting strategies such as Incredible Years, The Solihull Approach and Take 3. With secondary support on healthy relationships, parental conflict, home conditions, safety in the home and applications for funding/grants.

What happens next?

Referral

Referrals are accepted into the service via Leeds City Council's family support allocations panel

Initial contact

The assigned family support worker will make contact with both the family, referrer and surrounding agencies.

Planning

Family Support Workers will work alongside families and supporting agencies to identify a clear piece of work which works alongside existing plans of intervention.

Support

Family Support Workers will offer regular contact to families through home visits, phone calls and attendance at core groups.

Reviews

Plans will be regularly reviewed with the family to assess ongoing progress. Family Support Workers will contribute to reviews across the core group.

Closure

Family support workers will work with families and the core group to meet our identified outcomes prior to closure, when possible.
