We are looking for a Support Worker to deliver the This Is Me programme to parents and carers of children with additional needs, virtually and in person and to deliver direct work with children in school. The programme works with families of children to support them in understating their emotions and how to support their behaviours. You will be working with a team of support workers in doing this and full training will be given.
