Job Summary

Family Action are looking for a Group Facilitator to join our team. Our services include a telephone helpline, counselling, advocacy, outreach and a co-produced, relational activism project.

This is an exciting opportunity, for an experienced facilitator, to work on group-based provision for adult survivors of domestic abuse. You will be responsible for co-designing course materials for both remote and in-person groups and for training a small group of volunteers to support you in your role.

You will lead the promotion, delivery and evaluation of psycho-educational pre-therapy groups and post-therapy drop in groups and coproduce a steering group for lived experiences for adult survivors of domestic abuse in and around the Gloucestershire area who have access to safe accommodation.

There will be 3 hours per month of paid clinical supervision plus line management supervision with the Communities co-ordinator.
